

June - Garden Plant of the Month

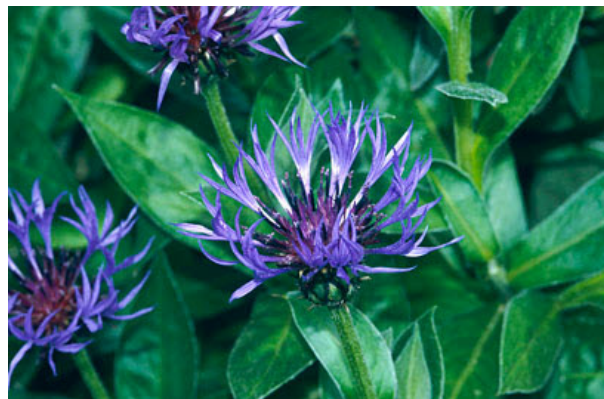
Many plants attracted pollinators during June. Here are some of them.



White clover on the lawn. Why not leave some patches for the bees!

Very popular with honey bees.

Foxglove - bees can get right inside to get at the nectar.



Knapweed (Centaurea). Bees love knapweed and once the flowers are finished, goldfinches will enjoy pulling out all the seeds. Pic from RHS

Also - fruit crops, especially raspberries and tomatoes. Bumblebees help to give you bigger crops through 'buzz pollination'
